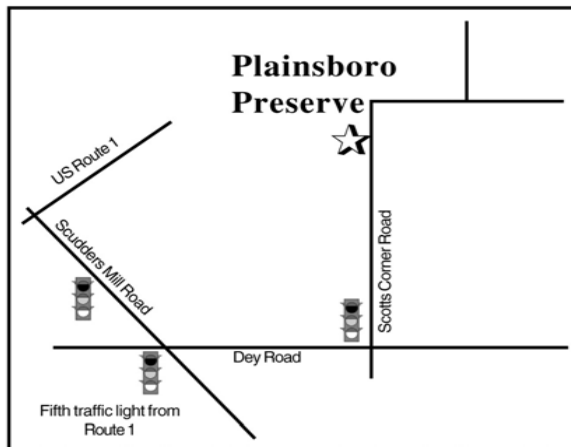

From US Route 1, take the Scudders Mill Road exit. Follow to the fifth traffic light (Dey Road). Make a left onto Dey Road and head east for about 1 ½ miles to Scotts Corner Road. Turn left onto Scotts Corner Road. Follow for about ¼ mile past the Community park on your left. The preserve entrance will be on your left. Turn into the entry gate and follow the entry road back to the parking lot on your right. ■

## W elcome to New Jersey Audubon's "B-Earth-Day" Parties.

Each program is designed to explore nature through a theme. A portion of each program may be spent outside building a connection to the natural world through fun and informative activities. We provide a highly trained environmental educator for each celebration.

Our goal is simple. We want to build memories that will last a life time while encouraging a connection with the natural world. Each two hour B-Earth-Day celebration includes a one hour educational nature program plus an additional hour to exchange gifts, eat, and celebrate in one of our classrooms.

### Set-up/Clean-up:

We provide tables, chairs, garbage and recycling cans. Thirty minutes are allotted for set-up and clean-up. Parents can provide decorations that are easily removed without damage to the room. No balloons please.

Parents are responsible for tablecloths, plates, cups, flatware, napkins, food and beverages. Adults are responsible for removing decorations and depositing garbage and recycling into proper receptacles. Call for a list of local food providers that deliver to the center.

## B-Earth-Day celebrations last for 2 hours.

**COST:** \$200 for parties consisting of 15 children. An additional charge of \$5 per child for parties with 16-20 children.

Parties with more than 20 children require a second room and instructor. The cost is \$325 for up to 30 children with \$5 per additional child. Parties are a NJ Audubon membership privilege. A \$50 non-refundable deposit is required to reserve your party.

### Live Animals

(grades pre-K-6)
