

Southeast Arizona's Second Spring: July 23 to 29, 2010

Day-to-day Itinerary:

July 23: Mount Lemmon (Molino Basin, Rose Canyon Campground, Summerhaven, Ski Area, Bear Wallow, Marshall Gulch)

July 24: Florida Wash, Madera Canyon, Rio Rico, Pena Blanca Lake, to Sonoita

July 25: Patagonia Roadside Rest Stop, Blue Heaven Rd, Kino Springs, Paton's feeders

July 26: Patagonia Lake State Park, Sonoita Creek Natural Area, Harshaw Creek Rd

July 27: Sonoita grasslands, Miller Canyon (including Beatty's feeders/orchard)

July 28: Carr Canyon (Reef Townsite Campground), Benson Sewage Treatment Plant

July 29: Garden Canyon, Scheelite Canyon Trail, Fort Huachuca, Benson STP
